

Squaring the Circle

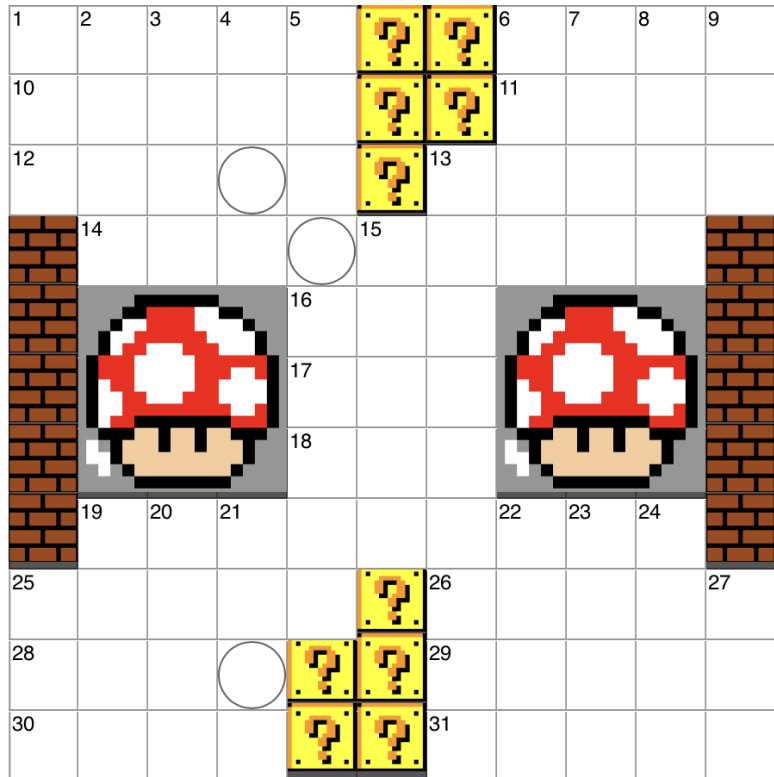
It's cram time! Looks like we need to think outside the box and inside the circle. Lastly, I'd say to avoid getting tilted, until you've had your fill.
